



Code of Conduct

1. The captain is responsible at all times for ensuring that play is conducted within the spirit of the game as well as within the laws.
2. Whilst representing the Club in any capacity or while present at the ground, players and team officials shall dress and behave in a manner befitting both the game and Waresley Cricket Club.
3. Players and team officials must at all times accept the umpire's decision. Players must not show dissent, verbal or otherwise, at the umpire's decision.
4. Players and team officials shall not, either verbally or physically, intimidate, assault or attempt to intimidate or assault an umpire, another player or spectator.
5. Players and team officials shall not use crude, abusive or racist language nor make offensive gestures.
6. Players and team officials shall not use or in any way be concerned in the use or distribution of illegal drugs.
7. Players and team officials shall not smoke or consume alcohol on the field of play.
8. Players and team officials shall ensure that their guests also adhere to this Code.
9. Players and team officials shall not disclose or comment upon any alleged breach of the Code or upon any hearing, report or decision arising from such a breach until any such hearing or decision has been satisfactorily completed.
10. Players and team officials shall not make any public pronouncement or media comment which is detrimental either to the game in general or to Waresley Cricket Club unless authorised to do so by the Club.
11. Any breaches of the Code will be dealt with by the Cricket Committee who will report their findings and actions to the Club Committee. All members have the right of appeal to the Club Committee.
